Reminder to always dress for the cold weather (hat, mitts, warm jacket, snow pants, and winter boots). Indoor recess when colder than -25C at the school.



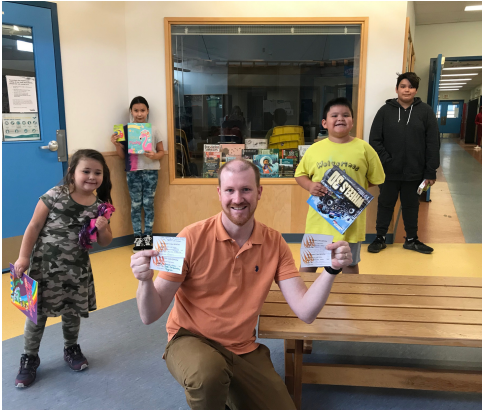
